Early Learning Coalition of Polk County's Enhanced COVID-19 Safety Plan



Prior to entering the Exhibit Hall area all attendees including competitors, vendors, show staff, and volunteers shall be vetted using the following method:



Outside the Exhibit Hall all attendees on day of show will have a mandatory body temperature check and it may not be above 100.4°. With a normal temperature reading attendee will enter the Exhibit Hall.



Ticket lines will be formed inside the Exhibit Hall doors with 6 feet social distancing between attendee.



Anyone with a body temperature above the normal range will be denied entry into the Exhibit Hall and will receive a refund for their ticket purchase amount.



Each will receive a wrist band, face mask and hand sanitizer for cleansing hands.

Additional Measure:



In the Exhibit Hall attendees will move around exhibits 6 feet from one another. There will be directional arrows to guide everyone through one-way aisles around the displays.

Show Ambassador Jeff G. Holt will make hourly reminder announcements regarding safe distancing throughout the two day event.



There will be additional hand sanitizer dispensers available throughout the Exhibit Hall during the show.



A COVID-19 tab is on the event website (cfwheelsofsteel.com) with RP Funding Center Clientele Guidelines and the ELC of Polk County's Enhanced Safety Plan.

NOTE: There will only be one entry area into the Exhibit Hall during the show. Any attendee that leaves the Exhibit hall will be re-screened for a temperature reading.
